

Cars can alert diabetic drivers

Soon, autos and trucks may let drivers know if their blood sugar dips to dangerous levels and remind people to take their medication. Building on a trend to add electronics to vehicles, Ford last month demonstrated a system to wirelessly connect vehicles to built-in medical devices like glucose (blood sugar) monitors. The company has developed 3 sample apps that include the glucose monitor from Medtronic, allergy particle alerts from pollen.com, and WellDoc, a mobile health-monitoring device.
