WellDoc Says Information Available 24-7

The results of a landmark study on diabetes are being released soon.

11 News reporter Jennifer Franciotti said it involves a clinical trial in Baltimore by a local company that is helping patients through mobile technology.

<u>WellDoc</u> is a healthcare software company that uses mobile applications to deliver coaching and selfmanagement support solutions to patients, Franciotti said. Its app is called <u>Diabetes Manager</u>.

Founder Dr. Suzanne Clough said the app is easy to use and allows patients 24-7 access to information about their numbers and steps necessary to make corrections.

The app is working so well for patients that the results from the clinical study are being released in the September issue of the American Journal of Diabetes.
