BALTIMORE -- **WellDoc** is one of **America's Most Promising Companies**, said Forbes.

The publication profiled 100 "privately held up-and-comers with compelling business models, strong management teams, notable customers, strategic partners and precious investment capital."

Baltimore-based WellDoc, coming in at 49 on Forbes' list, was Maryland's lone representative.

Forbes said WellDoc has raised \$5 million from friends and family, and angel investors.

Led by founder and CEO **Ryan Sysko**, WellDoc develops technology solutions to support chronic disease management "by integrating clinical, behavioral, and motivational applications with everyday technologies, like the internet and cell phone, to engage patients and healthcare providers in ways that dramatically improve outcomes and significantly reduce healthcare costs."

Topping Forbes' list was Colorado-based **Smashburger**, which operates a chain of 131 "fast casual restaurants."
